


VICINITY MAP

Area Covered by Detailed Map

Floating times vary considerably due to weather conditions, water conditions and type of craft. As a general rule, flatbottom boats and rafts travel at a rate of about 2.5 to 3.5 mph during high water (late May to late June) and from one to two mph during low water (early June thru August). Canoes, kayaks and boats with motors travel faster.
